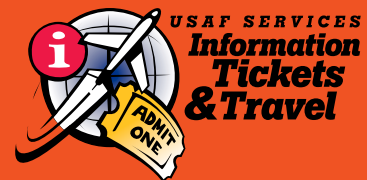

# Classes & Trips

## SKI TRIPS RIDES.

Meet at the Hobby Lobby, 525 S. 8th St. Colorado Springs, CO 80905, at 6 a.m. to load up. Van departs by 6:30 a.m. Arrival times at resorts will vary depending on traffic, distance and weather conditions. Enjoy a full day on the slopes, then load up at 4 p.m. If you are scheduling lessons at the resort many of them include a lift pass. Ages: 18+, unless accompanied by an adult. Cost: \$30. Lift ticket must be purchased separately. Get 50% OFF a ski/snowboard package (excluding performance packages) when you sign up for one of our trips! For more info, call 333-2940.

## MONARCH, LOVELAND RIDE & PASS, SKI TRIPS

These resorts are small enough to give you that friendly small-town, local feel, but large enough to offer the terrain and services you want! Cost: ONLY \$70 for transportations + lift pass! Transportation only: \$30. Rent your skis or snowboard from Outdoor Rec. for 50% off for this activity.

## ICE CLIMBING - INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED.

If you have climbed before or have taken one of our beginner classes and are ready for something a little more advanced, call us to set up a private course. We will take you to our intermediate/advanced site and go over vertical ice, ice anchors, and anything else you are interested in. Cost: \$85/person with a 2 person min./6 person max. Meeting time is 7 a.m. and we will return by 5 p.m.

## MOONLIGHT SNOWSHOE.

**Fri., Mar. 2; 5:30 p.m.** Explore the kingdom of Farish under the full moon light. Activity includes: transportation, snowshoes and guide. Cost: \$39. Five person min.

## SNOWMOBILE TOUR “HALF-DAY EXPRESS”.

**Sun., Mar 4; 8:30 a.m. at ORC.** Our three-hour ride is great for those who want to sleep in a little bit. You will see everything you see on the Monarch Park Scenic Tour PLUS the upper meadows and overlook. This trip also has more “free-ride” time and departs from our lodge (snow conditions permitting)

approx. 35 miles of riding. Cost: \$190 for single sled, \$245 total for a tandem sled that seats two. Activity includes: Transportation, guides, 1/2 day snowmobile trip, snowmobile clothing (helmet, warm outer layer and boots (common sizes) available.

## “OUT THERE” BIKE REPAIR CLASS

**Wed. & Thu., Mar. 7-8; 5:30-9 p.m.** Two-part class. Learn chain repair, derailleur and brake adjustments, wheel truing, tire repair and much more. Bring your own bike or we’ll provide one. The class will cover road, mountain and hybrid bikes. If you don’t emerge from this class with the confidence that you can fix your bike “out there,” you can attend the next class free for as many times as you need! Cost: \$39 one-time fee.

## INDOOR POOL KAYAKING CLASSES.

**Tue., Mar. 6; Apr. 3; 8-10 p.m. in the Fitness Ctr. pool.** Intro to Kayaking/Learn to Roll. For first-time kayakers. Learn basic skills including basic paddle strokes, boat control, balance, T-rescues and the Eskimo roll. Cost: \$30. Four persons min.

## AIARE LEVEL 1 AVALANCHE SAFETY COURSE

**Thu.-Sun. Mar. 8-11.** This four-day course is designed for winter back country users including skiers, snowboarders, snowmobiler, snowshoers and mountaineers. This course is comprised of two evenings and two field days. You’ll learn about key concepts, developing a common language in snow science and basic rescue techniques. In the field, you’ll dig observation pits, evaluate the snowpack, looking at different layers of crystals and more! Cost: \$460. Includes rental ski/snowboard/snowshoe gear, transportation for field days, avalanche safety equipment and instructors. Classes are taught by two instructors certified and trained through the American Institute for Avalanche Research and Education (AIARE). RecOn discount available for Active Duty and their dependents.

## SNOWSHOE DAY TRIP.

**Sat., Mar. 10; 8 a.m.** Explore the kingdom of Farish with a guide. Activity includes: transportation, snowshoes and guide. Cost: \$39. Five person min.

## INTRO TO BACKCOUNTRY SKIING/SNOWBOARDING.

**Wed., Mar. 14,21; 6:30 a.m.-6 p.m.** Get off the resort and spend a day skiing and riding your own personal powder. This one day trip will teach you the basics of using modern backcountry touring equipment, avalanche safety gear, and give you some perspective on how to stay safe and have fun. Cost: \$75

## SANTA FE EVENING BIKE RIDE.

**Wed., Mar. 21; 5:30-8 p.m.** Come for the ride, the fresh air, the exercise, meet new people, discover the world of cycling or just enjoy a low cost family activity. From Outdoor Rec, ride 15 miles south (downhill) down the Santa Fe trail to America the Beautiful Park. A van will be waiting to bring you back up the hill. Leaders for slower and faster groups. Bring a light for early dusk rides. Space is limited. Ages: 9+. Cost: \$5, kids under 16 are free but still need to sign up.

## BACKCOUNTRY WEEKEND ADVENTURES

**Fri.-Sun. Mar. 23-25.** This is an all-inclusive trips. Learn about traveling in the mountains in winter, avalanche safety, and ski/snowboard untouched powder, or snowshoe along high mountain ridges. An AMGA trained and experienced ski guide and AIARE Level 3 certified avalanche industry professional, will find you good snow, teach you about the mountains, and keep you fed and comfortable. Don’t ski? Snowshoeing is easy to learn and is also an option. Skiers and snowboarders should be physically fit, and proficient on black diamond slopes on ski resorts. Cost: \$260/person with a six person minimum/10 person max. Must be 16 years. Included: Ski/Snowboard/Snowshoe equipment, five meals, lodging for two nights, transportation and guide. RecOn Discount available

## DUTCH OVEN COOKING CLASS.

**Fri., Mar. 23; 5:30 p.m.** Want to cook in a Dutch oven, but don’t know where to start? Or maybe you just want to make some new friends. We can help! Learn proper heat management and some great recipes. We will cook up an entire meal. The best part, we sit down and eat our work at the end of class! Class is limited to 8 people, so sign up early for a full hearty Dutch oven meal! Class and recipes are planned as if you were camping, so cook times are 30–60 minutes long and ingredients are camping-friendly. Cost: \$25 per oven (up to 2 per oven, bring a friend), Dutch ovens, and all food included.

## OUTDOOR LASER TAG

**Sat., Mar. 24; Noon - 2:30 p.m.** Meet at FamCamp. Our 5-pound metal guns with red dot sights look like MP5s and use harmless infrared technology. We will set up a variety of games that will test your individual skills as well as how well you

work as a team. Players should wear closed-toed shoes and clothes that they don’t mind getting dirty. Special Group arrangements are available for friends, units, team building activities, birthdays and more. 10 pers. min., 20 pers. max. Ages: 9+. Cost: \$15/pers. for a 150-minute session. ## PHOTOGRAPHY & SNOWSHOE CLASS/TRIP.

**Sun., Mar. 25; 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m.** Come out and snowshoe as well as learn some outdoor photography from a professional. We will go up to Farish which is closed in the winter so we can get some great untouched snow. Learn how to use the natural lighting and camera features to get the picture of a lifetime. Cost: \$55/pers. Activity includes: transportation, snowshoes, professional photo instruction and guide. Snow conditions permitting.

## WINTER PUEBLO BIKE RIDE.

**Sat., Mar. 31; 9 a.m.** For those of us who just have to ride their bikes, we offer a “no snow we’ll go” bike ride on the bike paths in Pueblo. Ride is up to 30 miles long and all bike path. Road bikes will be best. Activity includes: transportation and guides. Cost \$29.

**A High Risk Activities Worksheet (AF 4391) is required to participate in ANY high risk activity, for ALL Active Duty Personnel. It is required to be completed by Active Duty Personnel before they participate in most of our Outdoor Rec Adventure Programs. This responsibility lies solely on the Active Duty participant.**

### OAP Cancellation Policy

- Full payment for all trips is due at time of registration.
- Cancellations within 72 hours of the activity date will NOT be refunded or rescheduled unless otherwise stated.
- Cancellations 30 days or more before a multi-day activity start date are refundable in full unless otherwise stated. Cancellations within 30 days of a multi-day activity will not be refunded unless someone takes your place on the activity. Any refunds issued in this case will result in a service fee of 10% of the total price for the activity.
- “No Shows” are non-refundable and will not be rescheduled.
- All trips are subject to cancellation due to unsafe weather or conditions outside of our control. In this event, the trip will be rescheduled or you may opt for a refund minus irretrievable deposits. In the case of cancellation due to insufficient participation, a full refund will be issued.
- Refunds may be given at any time when a medical emergency or military TDY/PCS orders prohibit participation. A signed doctor’s note or signed orders must be presented in order to receive a refund in these cases. If a refund is given for a multi-day trip in this instance, OAP will retain a service fee of 10% of the total price for the activity.
