SNOW AND ICE

INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED ICE CLIMBING

For those who have climbed before or have taken one of our beginner classes and are ready for something a little more advanced. We will take you to our intermediate/advanced site and go over vertical ice, ice anchors, and anything else you are interested in. Warm refreshments will be provided for the journey. Dress in layers, because you will warm up quickly, and wear sturdy waterproof boots and a jacket that covers your bum. Route is usually around three miles long, depending on conditions and abilities. \$39/person, includes transportation snowshoes and guide.

MOONLIGHT SNOWSHOE

Nov 25, 4–10 pm. Tired of being indoors? Come out on this *almost* full moon and

spend some time exploring the Kingdom of Farish on snowshoes. Whether you're donning snowshoes for the first time or if you're a pro, join us on this winter adventure! Route is usually around three miles long depending on conditions and abilities. Bring your own light. \$39/person, includes transportation snowshoes and guide.

OUTDOOR FUN

INTRO TO TRADITIONAL CLIMBING / INTERMEDIATE ROCK DAY

Nov 4, 7 am-5 pm. If you have climbed before and are interested in learning traditional climbing, and want to push yourself to learn new styles at different difficulties, this trip is for you! Prices start at \$150/person, includes transportation, guides, and necessary equipment. Twoperson max./six-person max.

OUTDOOR LASER TAG

Nov 4, 12–2:30 pm. Need to get out of the house?! Outdoor Laser Tag is the perfect solution. Our field is huge and features lots of trees, rocks, bushes, barrels and pallets to use as cover. We will set up a variety of games that will test your individual skills as well as how well you work together as a team. Meet at USAFA FamCamp. Activity includes: refs, and needed gear. \$13.50/ person for a 150-minute session. You can also arrange for a Special Group Arrangement (SGA), for friends, units, team building activities, birthdays and more. Contact us early for availability and to book. Ten people min, 40 people max. Ages 9+.

WINTER BIKE RIDE IN PUEBLO

Nov 5; 9 am–5 pm. For those of us that just "have to ride" their bikes, we offer a "no snow we'll go" bike ride on the bike paths in Pueblo. Pueblo is usually 10-15+ degrees warmer than the Springs. Ride is an out and back from the river walk to the Marina on Pueblo Res. Ride is up to 30 miles (can easily be shortened to 20 miles) long and all bike path. Bikes may be rented for half off regular price for this activity but must be reserved no less than three duty days prior to activity date. Activity includes transportation and guides. \$35/person.

For all biking activities: bikes are available for rent at a discounted rate through Outdoor Rec but must be reserved at least three days prior to date of activity.

CLASSES

ADULT/CHILD CPR CLASS

Nov 19, 9 am–3 pm (30-minute lunch break). Get your American Red Cross Adult/Child CPR, AED, and First Aid Certification with Certified Red Cross Instructors. We teach Adult/Child CPR, AED and First Aid, rescue breathing, procedures for choking victims and more. Our goal is to teach you the skills so that in the event of an emergency, you will have the skills and confidence to assist someone in need. Certification is good for two years. \$75/person.

2023 AMERICAN RED CROSS ADULT/CHILD CPR, AED, & FIRST AID RECERTIFICATION

Recertify your American Red Cross Adult/ Child CPR, AED, and First Aid. This is a hybrid recertification course and includes a three-hour online training and two-hour skills test. Online training link will be sent to you one week prior to the scheduled skills test and must be completed before attending the skills class. Registration will close one week prior to the scheduled skills test. You must be able to provide proof of previous certification and not exceed expiration of certification by more than 30 days. Contact ODR for course information, 719-333-4475. \$50/person.

EQUIPMENT RENTALS

SKI/BOARD RENTALS

2023-2024 Season Ski/Snowboard Rentals. Appointments are required - Call to check availability (719-333-4753/4356). Season equipment is due back NLT April 16, 2024.

Daily Ski Rentals begin Friday, Nov 17, conditions permitting. Dailyuse customers are encouraged to be fitted early by appointment only (starting Nov 14) and use the one-week advanced reservation policy. Once current fittings are in the system, call a week prior to desired pick-up day. Great for busy holiday weekends!

EQUIPMENT RENTAL RESERVATION POLICY

For high-demand equipment other than skis.

Active duty can reserve high-demand equipment a maximum of 90 days from date of pick up. All other eligible customers can reserve 60 days from date of pick up. All reservable items require a full payment upon reservation. Any reservation canceled will be charged 10% cancellation fee. Any reservation canceled within 72 hours will lose their full deposit, unless it is a documented military commitment or medical emergency.

FARISH RECREATION AREA

CLOSED for the winter. Will open May 3, 2024

RESERVATION POLICY

Reservations can be made 90 days in advance only for active duty personnel and 60 days in advance for all other eligible users. Customers are authorized to make reservations a year in advance for large events that require at least 50% of all indoor lodging. These groups are ONLY authorized to make reservations during non-peak months (May, Aug, Sep, Oct) and will ONLY be scheduled Sundays to Thursdays (no weekends). All weekends and the months of June and July are for the resiliency of individual families. Call 719-687-9098 for more information. FAMCAMP

Office CLOSED for the winter. The office will re-open on April 1, 2024. Winter rates are effective Nov 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024.

Nightly rate for ID card holders is \$30. Monthly rate is \$750 per calendar month only, beginning Nov 1, 2023 (monthly rate is NOT based on 30 day increments). Any additional day before or after the last day of each month is \$30 each.

Guest RV's are not permitted during winter operations. Tent sites are CLOSED for the winter, car camping is not allowed in any form.

Temporary storage is available through March 31: \$5/day, \$55/ month w/out electricity; \$7/day, \$135/month with electricity.

Reminder – IAW AFI 34-101, FamCamp guests may stay a total of 180 days per calendar year.

FAMCAMP RESERVATION POLICY

FamCamp reservations for the 2024 summer season can be made 90 days in advance by active duty personnel, 60 days in advance by retirees, DOD civilians, VHIC and all other eligible users. Cadets/Prep school students are authorized to make reservations a year in advance for visiting family for Graduation and Parents Weekend. AOG Members are authorized to make reservations a year in advance for alumni events. (These guests must be an AOG member with ID card or sponsored by AOG) Contractors are NOT eligible to stay at FamCamp.

VANDENBERG HALL

Hours of Operation are Mon/Tue/Thu/Fri, 0800-1700; Closed Wed, Sat, Sun and Federal Holidays.

Cadet bus info - Advance Airport Bus Ticket sales for Thanksgiving (call by 7 Nov for bus scheduling purposes) and Winter Break (call by 1 Dec for bus scheduling purposes). DIA buses are \$65 Round Trip (R/T), \$45 one way and standby (no presale reservation and is cash only) are \$50. Colorado Springs buses are \$35 R/T, \$25 one way, and standby (no presale reservation and is cash only) are \$30. TRAIL RIDES

Guided group rides on our scenic forested and open trails are an excellent way to gain riding experience for beginners and to learn the trails for seasoned riders! **One-hour rides are \$60* per person, two-hour rides are \$110* per person.** *Prices are for DOD cardholders, add \$10 per guest for non-DOD cardholders in party. Winter Guided Trail Rides are on Saturdays and Sundays, and by reservation only. Space is limited.

HORSEMANSHIP LESSONS

Sign up for our English/Western horsemanship lessons. One-hour private lessons are \$65 per person, semi-private lessons are \$55 per person, and group lessons (3+ students) are \$50 per person. Lessons are for ages 8 and over, ages 6-7 evaluated on a case-bycase basis.

LEAD LINE

Rent a horse to lead your child around for them to gain experience. Lead line rides are for riders ages 6 to 12 years old, parent leads the horse. Under age 6 can rent our mini horses to pet/lead with parent supervision (no riding). Cost for Lead Line or mini horse rental is \$25 for 30 minutes.

GROUP/SPECIAL EVENTS

BOARDING

Eligible patrons may board their horse(s) at the Equestrian Center. Many boarding options. Call 719-333-2294.

Did you know you can trailer-in your own horse to ride on our trails? Day fee is \$10 in drop box, Yearly Passes are \$120 and can be purchased through the rental office.
