Reporting Requirements

Mandatory Reporters

- Commanders and First Sgts
- AOC and AMT
- Any military or civilian in supervisory chain
 - Immediate Supervisor
 - Element Leader
 - Flight Commander
- MCIO (SFS, OSI, CID, NCIS)
- AF instructors, with the exception of AFA civilian & military instructors

Highly encouraged

- Military members and civilians (non-supervisory role) who become aware of an alleged sexual assault
- Roommates
- Co-workers
- Spouses/Friends
- * **Evaluate the situation** *
 - Threat to life--Law Enforcement
 - No threat to life--SARC

It is always appropriate to contact the SARC @ 333-SARC (7272) to understand what options are available
