

Casualty Assistance Representative

The Casualty Assistance & Survivor Benefit Office is located at the Airman and Family Readiness Center.

Air Force Casualty Services provides prompt reporting, dignified and humane notification, and efficient, thorough and compassionate assistance to active duty family members and beneficiaries. The program provides guidance to commanders, casualty assistance representatives, family liaison representatives and many other support agencies to ensure members and their families are taken care of as expeditiously as possible in a family emergency.

Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP)

The government offers SBP as a monthly survivor annuity, which is available at the time of retirement to all active-duty and reserve retirees. For a monthly premium, the SBP provides up to 55 percent of a member's monthly retired pay to his or her survivors. To participate in the SBP or the Reserve Component SBP, or to decline participation, both the retiring service member and spouse must agree to the option in writing.
