### INTRODUCTION TO MATTING AND FRAMING

Tue, March 7 or April 11, 5:30 – 8:30pm;  
 Sat, March 18 or April 22, 9am – noon. In this one-session class, learn to frame your own art and photos. Plan a project, cut the mat and frame, then assemble into a finished piece. Bring a 5" x 7" or 4" x 6" photo with you and leave with an 8" x 10" project ready to hang on the wall. **\$65/person, includes materials.**

### WOOD SHOP ORIENTATION

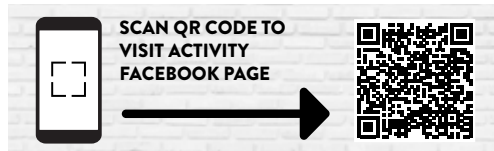
Thu, March 9 and 23, April 6 or 20;  
 5:30 – 7:30pm. Required to use our wood shop, this class covers the safe use of wood shop machinery. **\$15/person.**

### CHILDREN'S CRAFT CLASS

Sat, March 11 or April 15; 1 – 2:30pm. Kids ages 5 – 12 create a craft or piece of art. Projects vary from clay to paper to natural materials. **\$15/person, includes materials.**

### INTRODUCTION TO BEAD STRINGING

Sat, March 11 or April 8; 1 – 3pm. Construct a bracelet of your design to learn the basics of beading. **\$35/person, includes materials.**



### PEN TURNING

Thu, March 16; 5 – 7pm. This class teaches the basics of using a small wood lathe. Take home a handmade pen at the end of the class. **\$45/person, includes materials.**

### PALLET PROJECTS

Fri, March 17; 5 – 7pm. Recycled wood from pallets is used to produce a 'Welcome to Colorado' sign. **\$35/person, includes materials.**

### INTRODUCTION TO WIRE WRAPPING

Sat, March 18; 1 – 3pm. Create a pair of earrings to learn how to wire wrap jewelry. **\$35/person, includes materials.**

### BEGINNING POTTERY WHEEL THROWING

Tuesdays, March 21 – May 2; (no class March 28)  
 6 sessions; 9:30 – 11:30am or 1:30 – 3:30pm or 5:30 – 7:30pm. This class teaches the basics of using a potter's wheel to produce clay vessels. All firing and shop use is included in the cost of the class. **\$100/student, clay extra.**



### BEGINNING STAINED GLASS

Wed, March 22, 29, April 5; 5:30pm – 7:30pm. In three sessions, the student learns basic stained glass techniques such as following a pattern, cutting and grinding, and soldering. The students take home a finished project at the end of the class. **\$75/person, includes materials.**

### GLASS FUSION

Sat, March 25; 10am – noon. In this two-hour class, students learn how to cut glass in the desired shapes and put together an image. The pieces will then go into the glass kiln where they will be fused together permanently. Ages 18 and up. **\$75/person, includes materials.**

### MOSAIC

Wed, April 12, 19 and 26; 5:30 – 7:30pm. This class teaches the art of mosaic using small glass pieces. You will design, cut, glue and grout your mosaic project. Students will need to come in outside of class to complete project. **\$50 per student, includes materials.**

### BASIC KNITTING

Thu, April 13, 20, 27, May 4;  
 10:30am – 12:30pm. This four session class teaches the basics of knitting a scarf. No experience required. **\$65/person, supply list available at sign-up.**



### CROCHET

Thu, April 13, 20, 27; 1:30 – 3:30pm. This three-session class teaches the basic of crocheting a scarf. No experience required. **\$65/person, supply list available at sign-up.**

### CHARCUTERIE BOARD

Thu – Fri, April 13 – 14; 5 – 7pm. Learn to make a wooden platter used to serve a selection of meats, cheese and fruits. **\$65/person, includes materials.**
