RECHARGE FOR RESILIENCY (R4R) PROGRAMS

RecOn: Air Force and Space Force Active Duty, Reserve, Guard personnel and their valid ID family members. These programs are specifically high adrenaline supervised by ODR.

Single Airman Program (SAPI): Air Force and Space Force Active Duty, Reserve, and Guard officer or enlisted without a spouse. *Note: new this year SAPI eligible may sponsor one guest at the R4R price.*

Deployed Affected (DAP): Deployed affected Air Force and Space Force Active Duty, Reserve, Guard personnel and their family members. The deployed service member and their family are eligible upon receiving official orders during the deployment and up to 1 year after the service member returns to the home station. *Note: new this year DAP eligible families may sponsor one guest at the R4R price.*

Outdoor Rec is offering several programs throughout the year that qualify for R4R pricing including snowmobiling, dogsledding, indoor and outdoor rock climbing, rafting, golf, bowling, and arts and crafts. Please go to *usafasupport.com* for dates and details, and call 719.333.4753 for more information. For R4R discount, trip enrollment must be in person with ID card present.

ELIGIBILITY: The Recharge for Resiliency (R4R)

initiative is directed specifically toward the Active Duty and Reserve members to include their families at each base. Unfortunately this means that retirees, civilians and foreign military are NOT eligible for R4R discounted rates. Other branches of the US military are not eligible unless they are part of an Air Force led joint-based scenario, or are permanently assigned to an Air Force base. Even then, they are only eligible at the Air Force Base in which they are assigned.

ADULT CPR CLASS

Get your American Red Cross Adult/Child CPR, AED, and First Aid Certification with Certified Red Cross Instructors. We teach Adult/Child CPR, AED and First Aid, rescue breathing, procedures for choking victims and more First Aid training. Our goal is to teach you the skills so you will have the confidence to assist someone in need in the event of an

emergency. Certification is good for two years. Five-person minimum, ten-person maximum. Call ODR at 719-333-4475 for dates and to enroll. This is not a babysitter course.

ADULT CPR RECERTIFICATION

Recertify your American Red Cross Adult/ Child CPR, AED, and First Aid. This is a hybrid recertification course that includes a three-hour online training and a two-hour in-person skills test. Online training link will be sent to you one week prior to the scheduled skills test and must be completed before attending in-person. Registration will close one week prior to the scheduled skills test. You must provide proof of previous certification and not exceed expiration of certification by more than 30 days. OAP CANCELLATION POLICY

Full payment for all trips is due at time of registration. All trips are subject to cancellation due to unsafe weather or conditions outside of our control. In this event, the trip may be rescheduled, or you may opt for a refund minus irretrievable deposits. In the case of cancellation due to insufficient participation, a full refund will be issued. Cancellations within 7 days of the single-day activity start date will NOT be refunded or rescheduled unless otherwise stated.

Cancellations within 30 days of a multi-day activity start date will NOT be refunded unless someone takes your place on the activity. Any refunds issued in this case will result in a service fee of 10% of the total price for the activity. Cancellations 30 days or more before a multi-day activity start date are refundable in full unless otherwise stated.

Refunds may be given within 30 days of the activity when a medical emergency or military TDY/PCS orders prohibit participation. A dated and signed doctor's note or signed orders must be presented within 72hrs of the document issue date in order to receive a refund in these cases. If a refund is given for a multi-day trip in this instance, OAP will retain a service fee of 10% of the total price for the activity. No refunds will be given in these cases after 30 days from the trip start date. "No Shows" are non-refundable and will not be rescheduled.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL

Camping equipment and party equipment rentals are available for rent. Active Duty may reserve 90 days in advance of rental date. All other eligible ID card holders may reserve 60 days in advance of rental date. Full payment is required at time of reservation. Go to *usafasupport.com/outdoor-*
